



How to do a Simple Search of the planning register (including how to receive e-mails highlighting new applications)

Once you have registered to use the public access system and logged in to the system. You will see this screen.

You can make a search as complicated as you like, but a basic search would be as follows;

You can select the criteria by using the drop down list to change to a different Parish, type of application, status etc. Once you have added in the criteria click **Search**. This search criteria will bring back into the results page, any application within the parish of North Cerney that has a status of waiting for a decision. In other words all outstanding applications within the parish. Once this search is saved, by clicking on **Save Search** at the top of the results page. You will see this screen appear and you can just rename the Search Title to something more meaningful. You need to make sure that you click the radio button to ensure the system sends you email confirmation of any new applications that match your criteria


You can run these searches at any time, edit them or delete them from this screen

Again from the main simple search screen select the tab Weekly/Monthly Lists


