



Application for prior notification of proposed agricultural development – proposed fish tank

These notes provide a checklist to determine what information the Council requires to be submitted with your application. If the information that is required is not included with your application, then it will be made invalid and we will not register or process it. In this case, we will try and speak directly to you stating what additional information is required and how this can be supplied.

Required Plans. (All plans should indicate: key dimensions and a scale bar. Imperial scales are <u>not</u> acceptable) For further information, e.g. on electronic submission and submitting plans – Making a planning application	
Location Plan: Ordnance survey based, at a scale of 1:1250 or 1:2500. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Up-to-date, with north marked, and sufficient to locate the site. • Red outline to application site, • Blue outline to other land owned by the applicant. • The plan must cover a large enough area to enable the location to be easily found. 	
Plan showing the size of the holding on which the development is proposed This should include information on the total size of the holding and the size of the parcel of land where the development will take place.	
Existing and Proposed Block Plan: at a scale of at least 1:500. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The existing plan must show the existing structures, boundary treatments, trees etc on the site • The proposed plan must show the proposed development in relation to the site boundaries and other existing buildings on the site. • Any trees or public rights of way affected by the development should be shown 	
Proposed Elevations at a scale of 1:50 or 1:100. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Show the proposal in relation to the existing site and adjacent buildings. 	



<ul style="list-style-type: none">• All sides of the proposal must be shown and labelled.• Showing size and depth of fish tank
