

## Census 2011: how we live

The data in this section covers the usually resident population that lived in households, the type of accommodation we lived in, how many rooms we had, whether we had central heating and the number of cars and vans that we had access to. It also covers who we lived with within households and what our marital status was.

### Dwellings, accommodation & tenure

In general, the relative proportions of accommodation types remained the same in the District between 2001 and 2011. However, the percentage of households living in purpose-built flats, maisonettes or apartments in a block of flats or tenements rose in Gloucestershire (1.8 percentage points), and the South-West (2.8 percentage points)

The largest proportion of households spaces were Detached houses/bungalows (37.1%) compared to 30.6% in Gloucestershire, and 22.6% in England and Wales (rank<sup>1</sup> within E & W = 81)

A relatively high proportion of households owned their home outright – 37.8% compared to 35.5% in Gloucestershire, 35.4% in the South-West, and 30.8% in England & Wales. More homes were owned outright than with a mortgage or loan (27.9%), which is likely to be linked to the relatively older populations of the District.

The percentage of households who owned their house with a mortgage/loan decreased by 5.8 percentage points which appears to be a general trend (linked to the financial crisis?)

In general, average household sizes have not changed over the decade; the average household size in the District was 2.2 residents per household compared to 2.3 in 2001. The average in Gloucestershire was 2.3 (no change), the South-West was 2.3 (no change), and in England and Wales, it was 2.4 (no change)

On the other hand, the average number of rooms per household in the District remained the same with 6.1 rooms per household, higher than for Gloucestershire at 5.7 and England and Wales at 5.4

The 2011 Census asked about the number of bedrooms in households for the first time; the average number of bedrooms per household was 3 compared to 2.9 in Gloucestershire, and 2.7 in England and Wales (rank within E & W = 15)

3.6% of households lived in houses with an occupancy rating<sup>2</sup> (rooms) of -1 or less and 1.8% of households lived in houses with an occupancy rating (bedrooms) of -1 or less, lower than Gloucestershire, the SW, and E & W

Nearly all households reported that they had central heating (97.8%), an increase of 2.7 percentage points since 2001.

<sup>2</sup> The occupancy ratings of rooms and bedrooms are indicators of deprivation and overcrowding in a household. An occupancy rating of -1 implies that there is one room too few for the number of people living in the household

### Cars & vans

Households in the District had access to a relatively high number of cars/vans: 87.3% of households had 1 or more cars or vans compared to 82.9% in Gloucestershire, 81.1% in the South-West, and 74.3% in England and Wales

34.3% of households had 2 or more cars/vans (rank within E & W = 48), 9.1% had 3 or more cars/vans (rank = 27) and 3.8% had 4 or more cars/vans (rank = 23)

In 2001, there were on average 14 cars per 10 households in the District whereas in 2011 there were 15 cars per 10 households

### Marital status

In 2011, as in 2001, the largest marital status group was those people who were married, at 54.9%; although this was a decrease of 2.8 percentage points since 2001, the proportion is relatively high compared to other local authority areas (rank within E & W = 34)

Civil partnerships, as a new legal partnership status, were a small proportion of the total – 0.3% (193)

The percentage of single (never married) people increased from 23.4% in 2001 to 25.7% in 2011

### Household composition<sup>3</sup>

Of the 36,236 households, the most reported household type was where there was one family (65%); 30.2% of households had one person living alone (30.2%)

The proportion of households containing one married family decreased 2.2 percentage points from 40% in 2001 to 37.8% in 2011 (higher than Gloucestershire (35.7%) and the South-West (34%)). Although the decrease reflects the decrease in numbers of marriages since the 1970's, this category is not directly comparable between 2001 and 2011 because the 2011 category includes civil partnerships for the first time

More specifically, the married couples with dependant children (living in one family) group decreased by 2.3 percentage points over the decade

Overall, the percentage of one person households increased by 1.3 percentage points which was due to a large increase in one person households excluding aged 65 and over. The one person households: aged 65 and over group actually decreased by 1.2 percentage points, but still remains high relative to other local authority areas (rank within E & W = 36)

Nearly 28% of households are solely made up of members aged 65 and over

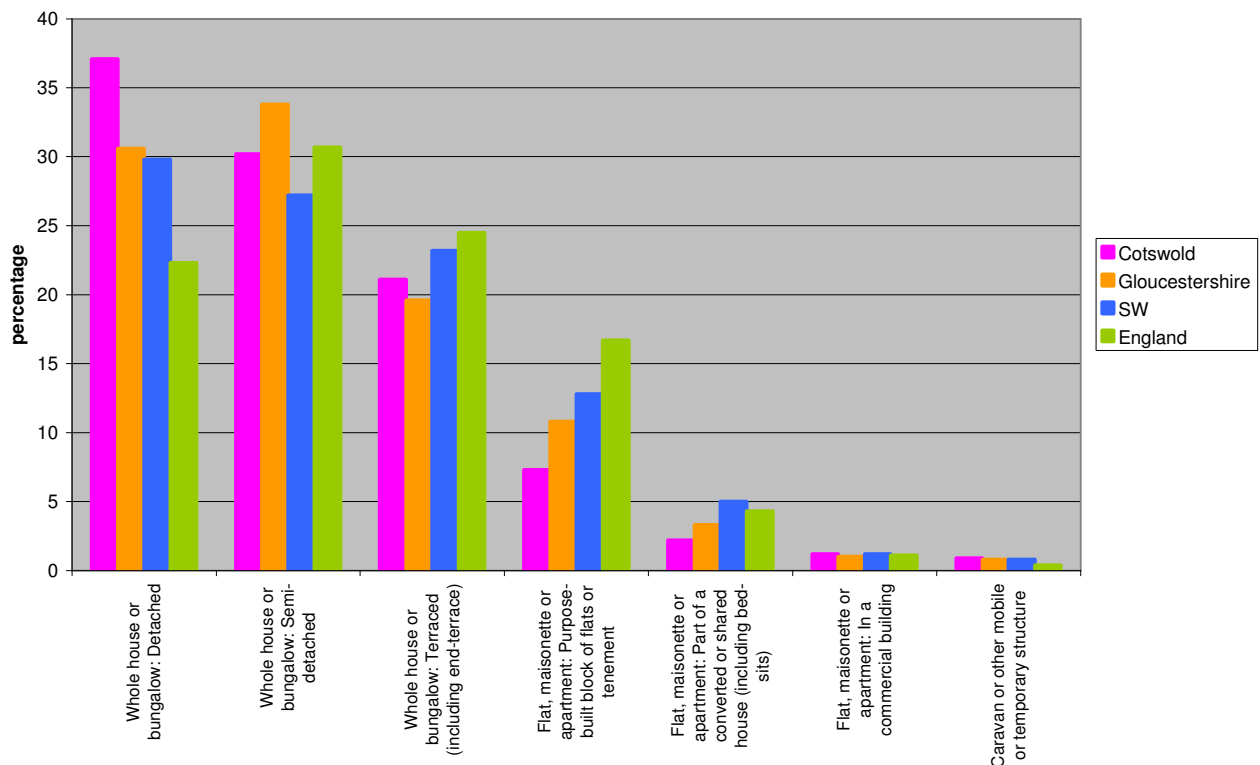

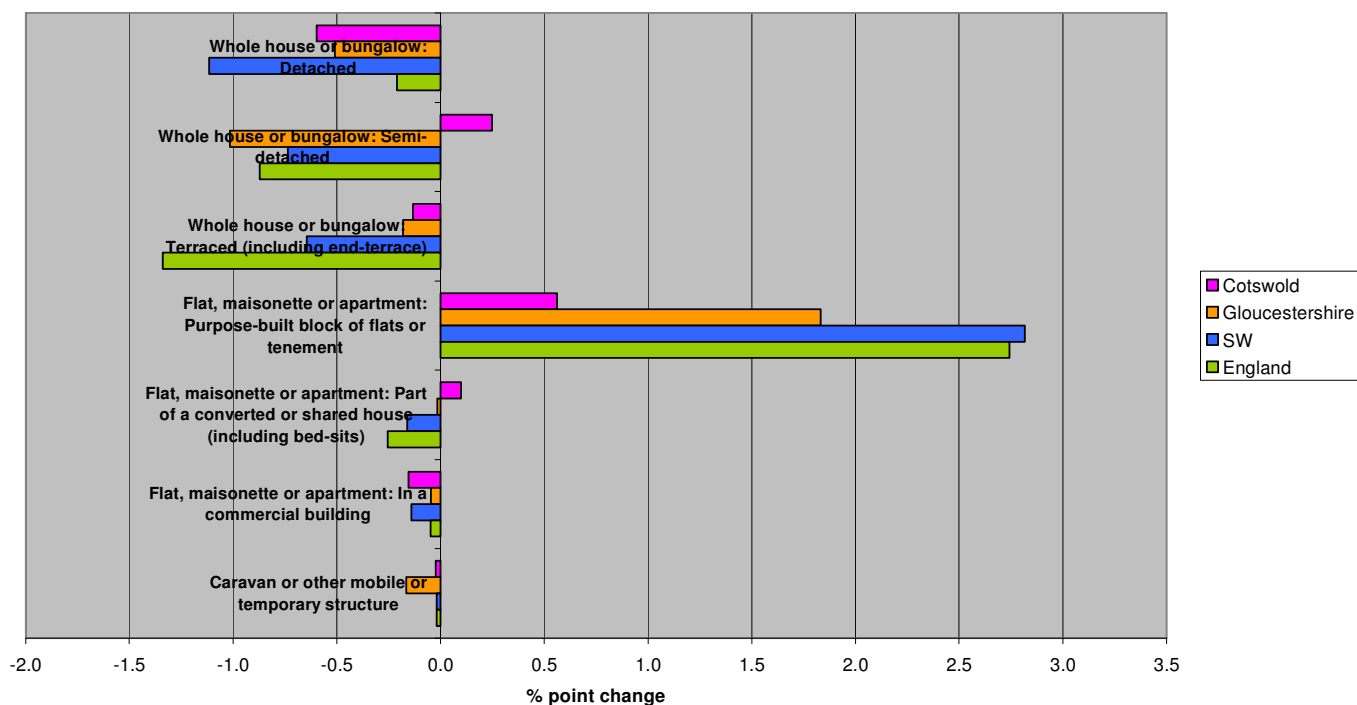

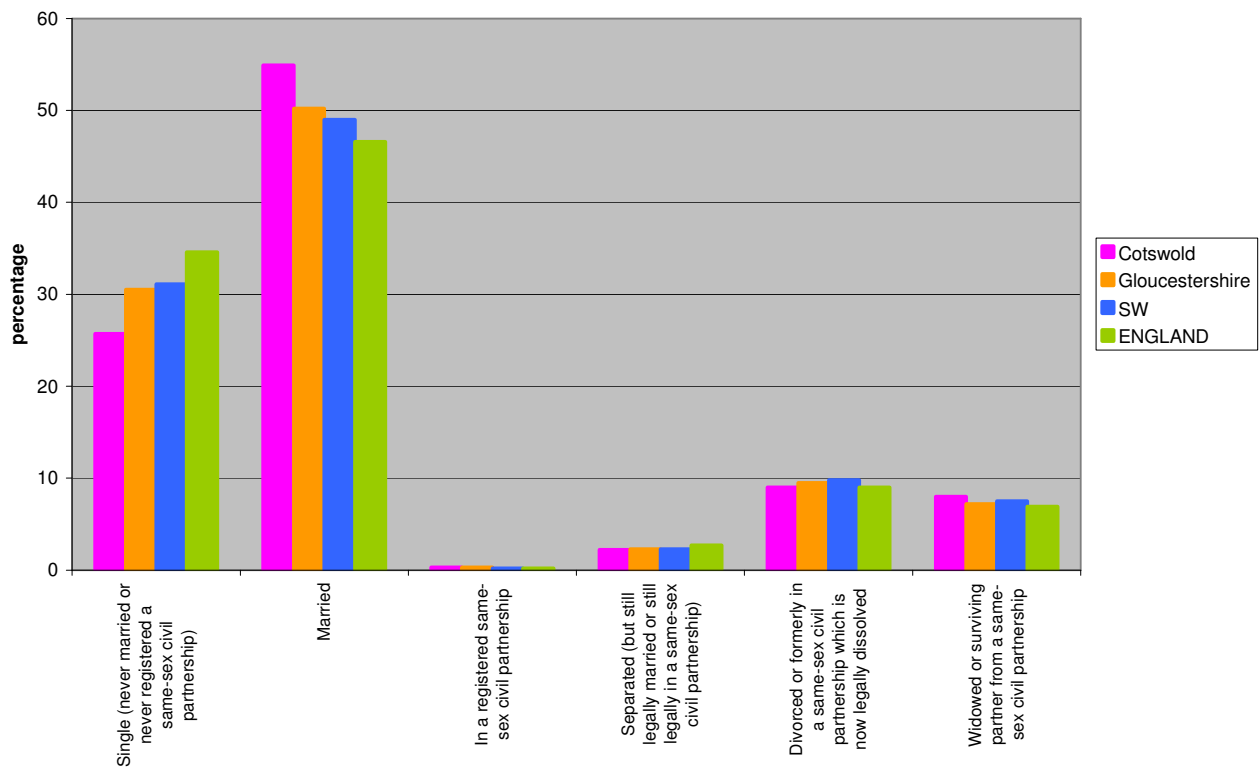

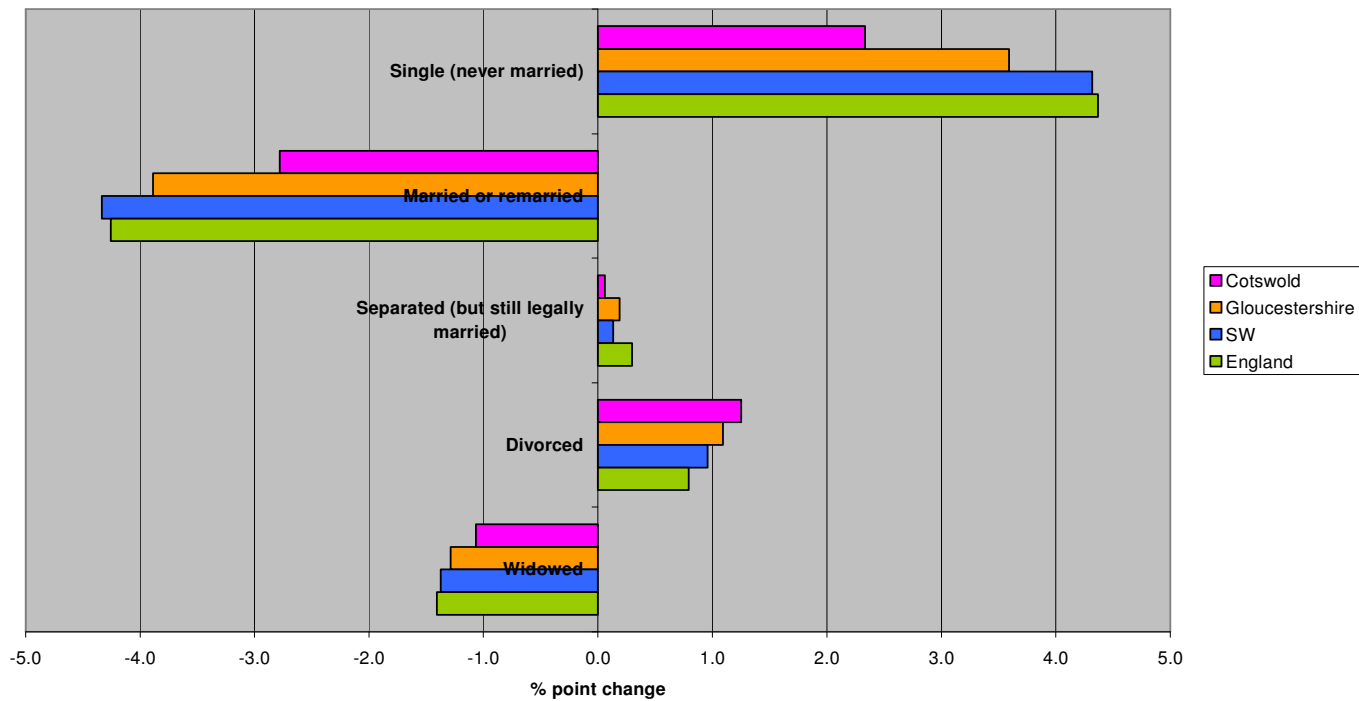

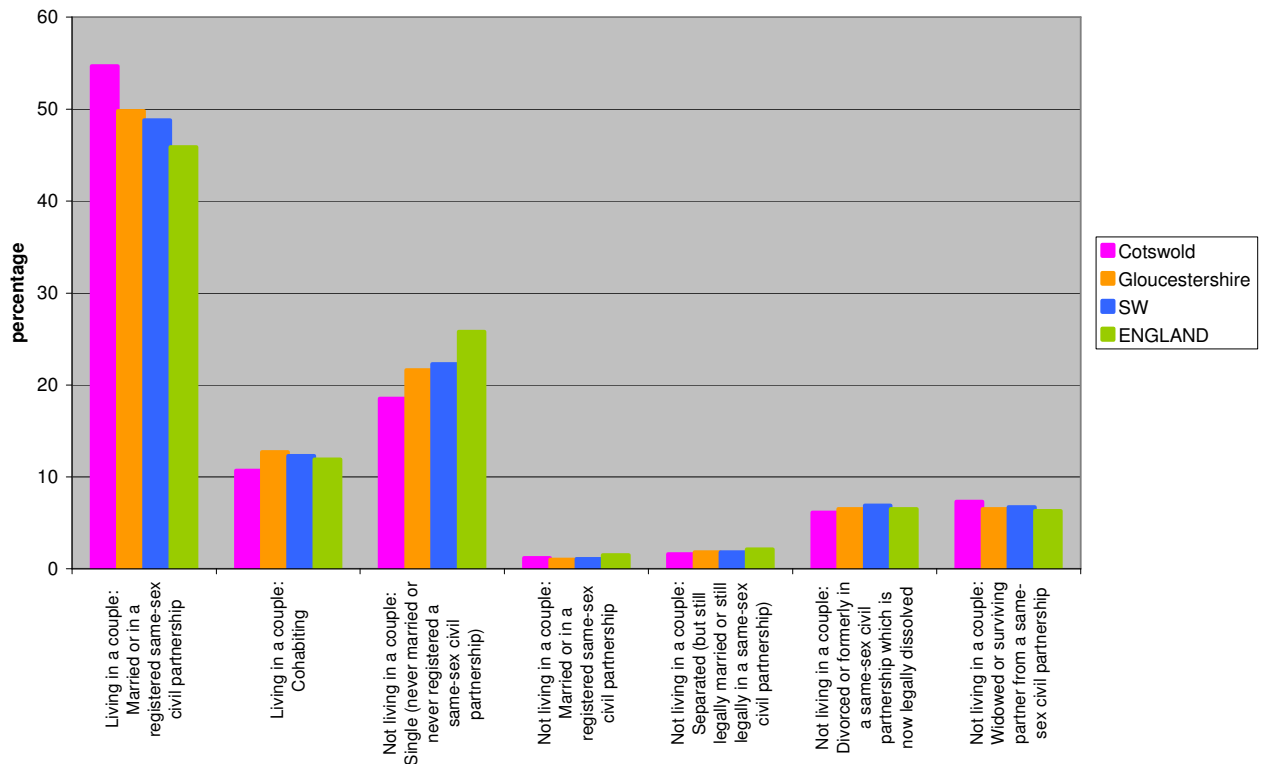

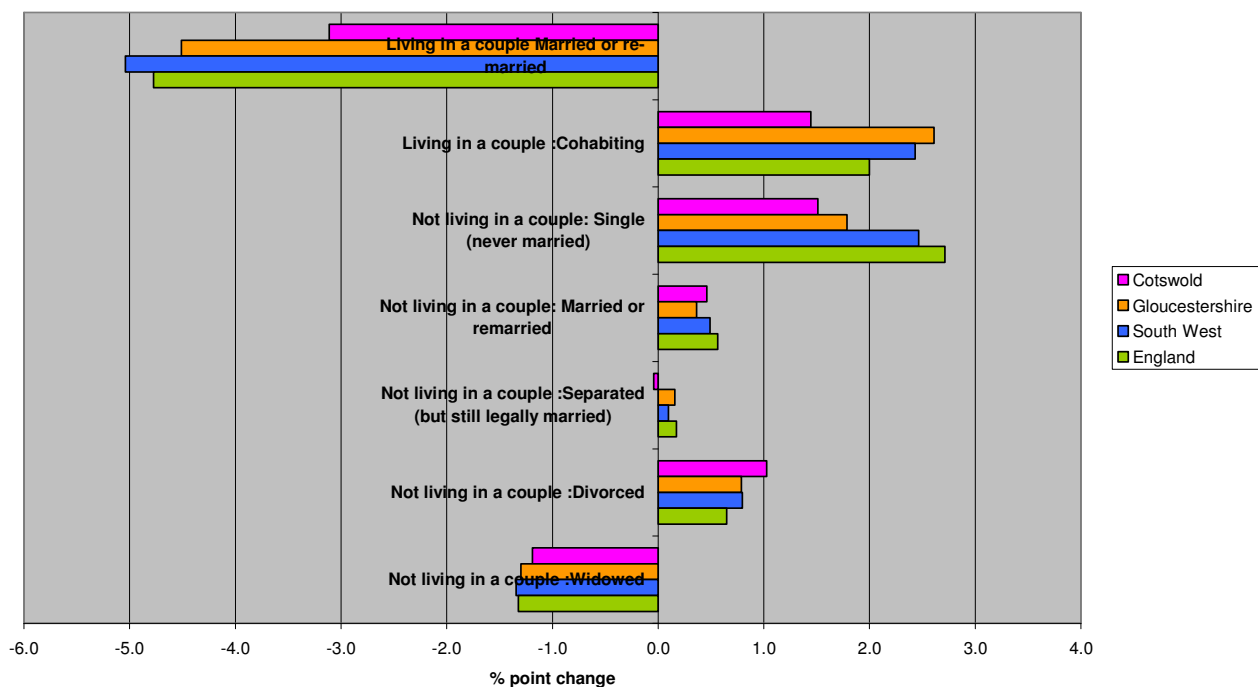

Change over decade



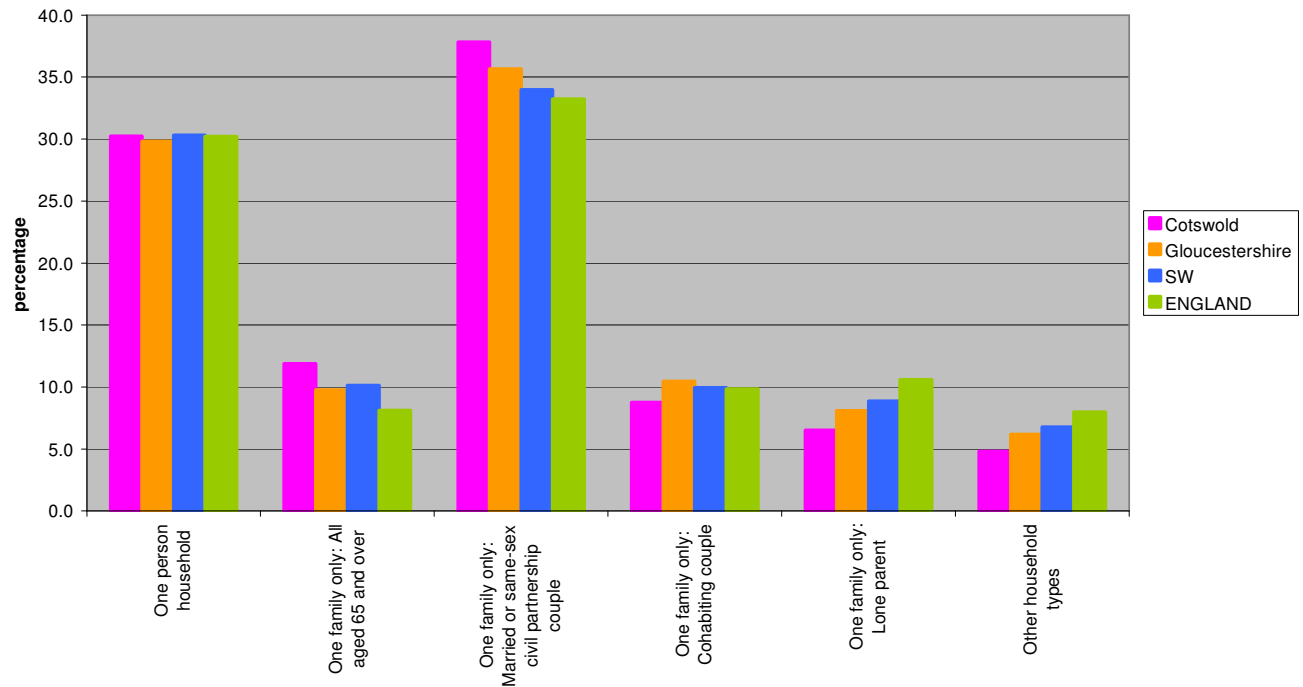

Household composition - all households



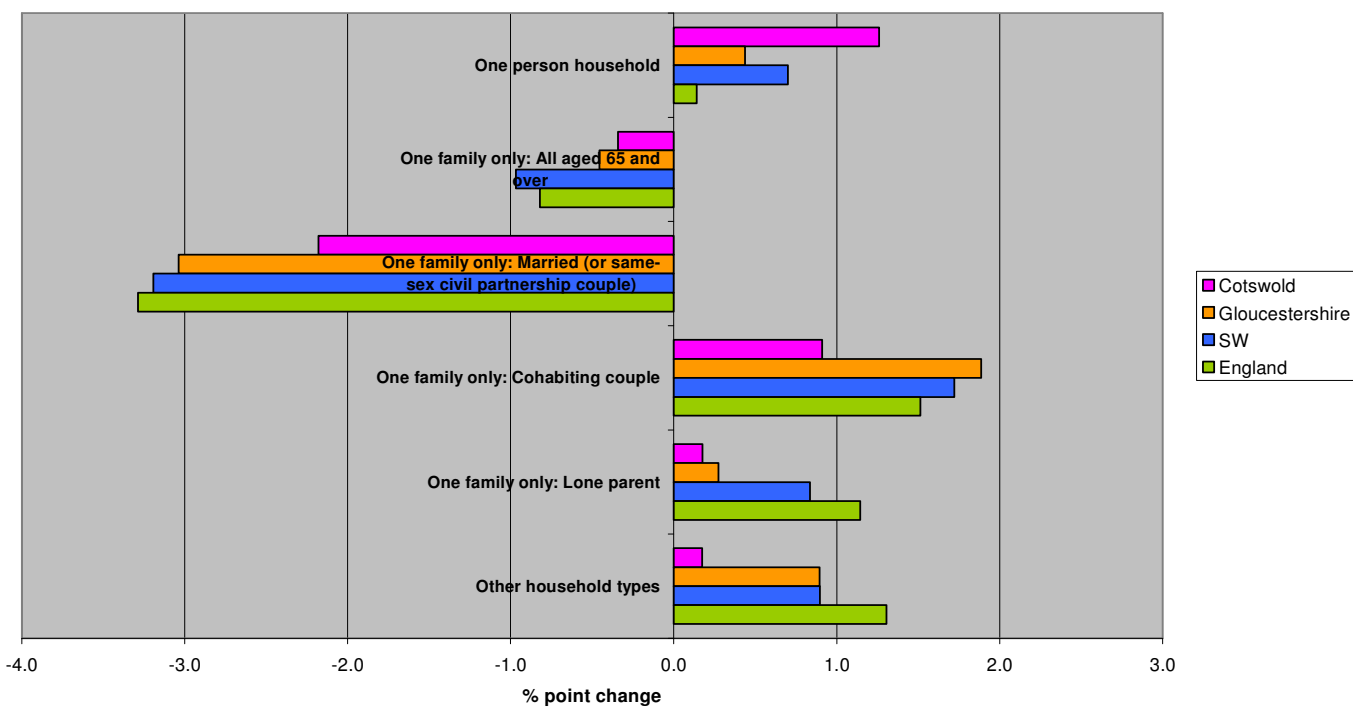

Change over decade



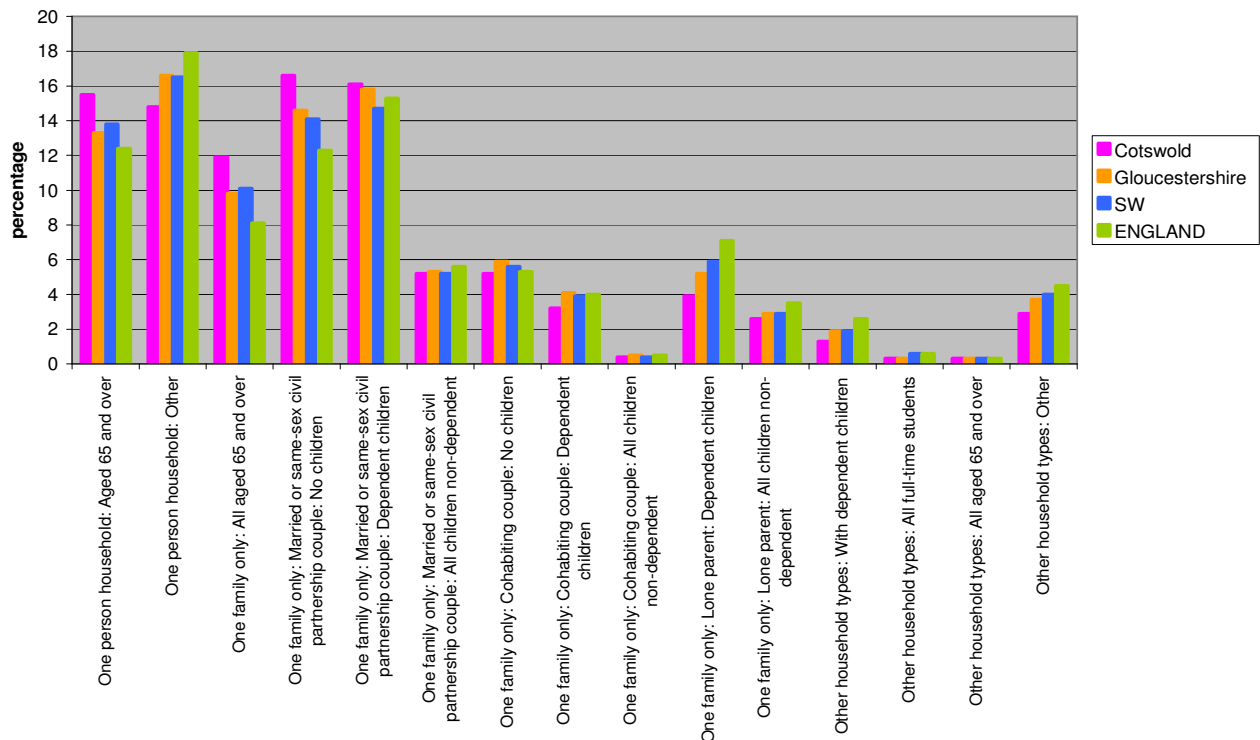

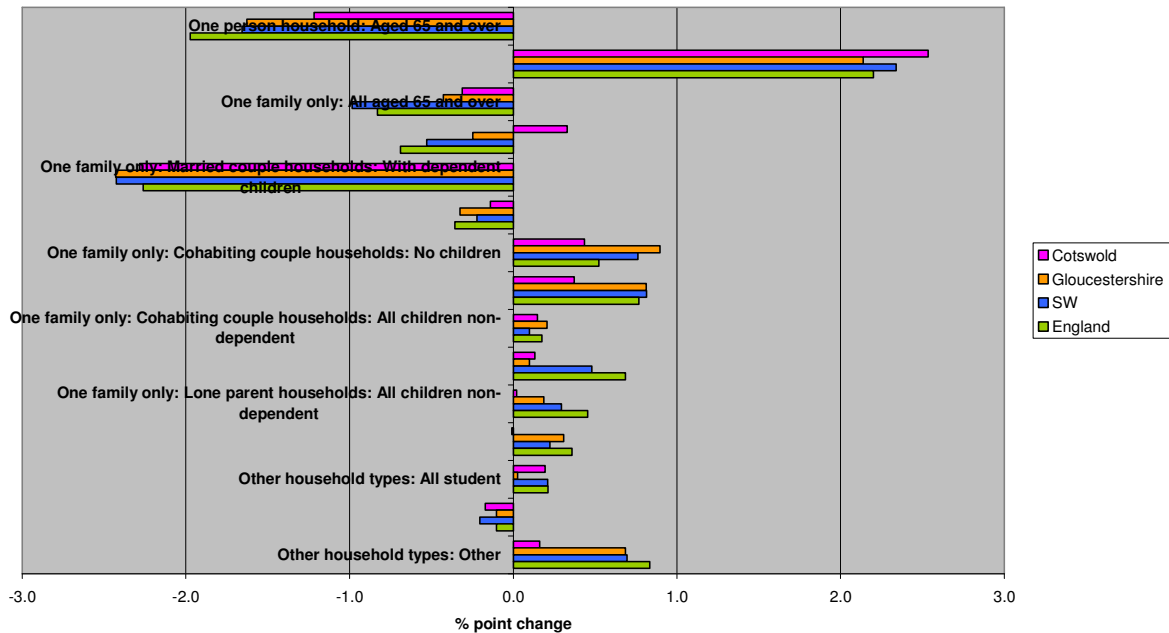
