

Direction restricting Permitted Development

WHEREAS GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL being the Local Planning Authority is satisfied that it is expedient that the development set out in the Schedule hereto should not be carried out on land being parcels numbers 12a, 103, 105, 106, 107, 108, 109 and part parcels numbers 12, 13, 14 and 102 on Ordnance Survey Map Glos. Sheets 21.12 and 22.9 (1922 and 1921 editions) in the North Cotswold Rural District and shown coloured pink on the attached drawing No. Cd.P.256 and known as land at Waterhead Barn, Donnington Hill in the said Rural District and comprising in total about 17.262 acres (hereinafter referred to as "the said land") unless permission is granted on an application in that behalf

NOW THEREFORE the said Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1963 hereby directs that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to the said development

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDER, 1963

Land at Waterhead Barn Donnington Mill

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 13th July, 1972, the Secretary of State for the Environment approved a Direction made by the Gloucestershire County Council pursuant to Article 4 of the above-mentioned Order in respect of land at at Waterhead Barn, Donnington Mill, being Parcel Numbers 12A, 103, 105, 106, 107, 108, 109 and part Parcels Numbers 12, 13, 14 and 102 on Ordnance Survey Map Glos. Sheet 21.12 and 22.9 (1922 and 1921 Editions) in the North Cotswold Rural District.

The affect of the Direction is that the permission granted by Article 3 of the above-mentioned Order shall not apply to the construction on the said land of concrete bases and the installation of fish tanks and the erection of associated buildings and structures being developed ^{or} under Class VI.I specified in Part I of Schedule I to the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1963 and that accordingly permission must be obtained from the Gloucestershire County Council as Local Planning Authority before any such development is carried out.

A copy of the said Direction and of the Map defining the area to which it relates may be seen during normal office hours at the Shire Hall, Gloucester.
