

The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012

Notice of Urgent Key Decisions

In accordance with the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012, notice is hereby given that Cotswold District Council intends to take urgent key executive decisions.

As compliance with Regulation 9 of the Regulations was impracticable, the agreement of the Chairman of the Council's Audit and Scrutiny Committee has been obtained that the making of the decisions is urgent and cannot reasonably be deferred (in accordance with Regulation 10(1) of the Regulations).

The decisions both relate to statutory requirements associated with the Cotswold District Local Plan, one in respect of the Local Development Scheme and the other in respect of the Statement of Community Involvement. Decisions on these items are required at the earliest opportunity so as not to prejudice and detrimentally affect the overall Local Plan timetable. The relevant executive decisions will be subject to the usual scrutiny arrangements.

It should be noted that there will be full consultation on the various documents associated with the Local Plan as work continues to progress.
